



Team Ford FIRST Task for Mid-Winter Event

The task for the Mid-Winter Event is described as follows:

Each team is to present their pit area to be used in Regional and National competitions.

Last year's rules may still be posted on the FIRST website (www.usfirst.org/robotics) in the section on Documents and Updates, or go directly to the archives posted at www.usfirst.org/robotics/2005/frcdocs.

Special reference is made to the following sections:

- Section 7 (At the Events) of last year's rules:
 - FIRST assigns each team a pit station.
 - Each pit station is approximately 10 feet by 10 feet.
 - At some regionals the area is as small as 9 feet by 9 feet.
 - Each team's pit station has a table and a power outlet.
- Section 6 (Robot Transportation) of last year's rules defines the maximum size and weight of the crate. The shipping crate will be taken to storage during the event unless it is totally integrated into the designated pit area.

Content of the pit MUST include highly visible presentation of Team Name, School(s), City, State, and Sponsor(s). Sponsors identification MUST include the Team Ford FIRST logo.

Other pit attributes include tools, work area, parts storage, lighting, displays, etc.

Teams will be expected to demonstrate set up, use, and disassembly of the pit.

Judging will be based on:

- Planning
- Display of team and sponsor information
- Time to set up the pit
- Pit layout and efficiency
- Time to dismantle the pit
- Shipping size
- "Pizzazz"
